Project #190: Pinwheels

- Cut a square piece of paper.
- Draw with felt markers or colour this as you like.
- Cut 4 slits on the diagonal as shown
- Fold each slit to the center and tape into place.
- Punch a hole into the center using a hole punch.
- Next insert a Push Pin (make hole smaller by poking it) or if your hole is larger, use a metal prong type pin that flares out after you place it into the hole spread the two prongs out to secure the pinwheel.
- This prong or push pin can then be inserted into a straw for the handle.

Activity:

On a slightly windy day, go outside and see how your pinwheel spins. Blow on it yourself to get it spinning. Place it in your garden or patio and watch it spin.
