Project #213 Spiders

- Use your whole hand to make the shapes of spiders.
- Press your hands into black paint.
- Place onto a piece of construction paper to form the two sides of the spider. Spiders have 8 legs so try to create your spider with the four fingers of each hand.
- You may also like to make smaller spiders by using your finger prints.
- Let the fingerprints dry and then draw the eight legs onto the spider's body.
- For both large and small spiders, you could add the small head and eyes.
- Add some spider webs by drawing or gluing some string onto your picture.
- Add some wool or threads to your spider.
- Create a sky or bush or trees for your spiders.

Activity: Spider Walk

Go for a walk and search for Spiders and Spider Webs. Observe your home as many spiders come in from the cold in this season. Look at books with various types of spiders. Some are poisonous. Be careful not to pick them up as spiders can bite. Teach the children to be mindful of the spiders. An example would be to put the spider outside again by an adult capturing it in a small container.
