Project #293: Boats!

- Cut out various shapes of various colours of construction paper. Include triangles, squares and circles.
- Arrange these on another piece of construction paper in the form of a boat. Sailboat, Tug Boat, Motor Boat, Ship, Ferry etc.
- Add some windows with the circle shapes.
- Add some square or rectangle windows as well.
- Around your boat, create some waves for the water.
- Add a line so you have some "land" above the water in your creation.
- Some light paint with a QTip works well for waves and some trees on the "Land"
- Add the clouds in the sky with some wispy white strokes with a very thin paint brush.
- When your picture is done, let it dry.
- Older children may want to add more to it such as some birds or more details.

Activity: Go to a Marina and view the various boats.
