Ann's Creative Corner Project #323: Headbands!

- Cut two long strips of construction paper (2 inches wide or so). -
- Staple, glue or tape them together in one long continuous strip
- Cut various flowers out of scrap paper.
- Cut leaves or other shapes from scrap paper.
- Glue these onto your headband strip.
- Try some stickers.
- Add some sparkles
- Do some of your own drawing with felt markers or crayons.
- This could also be used for a Birthday Crown if you make a crown shape and attach it to the front of your headband.
- Another idea would be to make various hat fronts for this such as Fireman, Police, Baker, Hard Hat, Clown Etc.
- Measure on the child's head and staple, glue or tape this together in a continuous circle shape (If using staples, please face the smooth edge in the inside of the band so the child's head does not get scratched.)

Have a flower day where you wear your Headband outdoors. Look for flowers and enjoy the sunny day! Pick some flowers. Place in a vase. Smell the flowers. Compare flower scent to perfumes!
