- Adding shapes of paper to it such as triangles would look good for a scarf.
- Try some sparkles and shiny paper.
- Bubble paper may give a nice texture.
- Make a design on a plain piece of paper with a variety of scarf shapes and sizes. This would be your collage of scarves. Try looking for a magazine or catalogue scarf pictures to cut out and glue on for a collage.
