Ann's Creative Corner Project #543: Recycle Gadget Prints and Painting!

(Project by Kids Care Preschool)

- Place a paper towel into a recycle container (recycle plastic is best for this)
- Pour some liquid non-toxic paint onto this to dampen it.
- Get your construction paper of any colour ready to print!
- Other types of paper may be used as well such as cardboard, wallpaper, plain white white paper etc.
- Gather some recycled tools for making prints such as plastic forks, spoons, plastic rope or string attached to a handle for dipping into the paint. Try lids, containers, cookie cutters etc as well.
- Children may dip the shaped item into the paint and make prints onto the paper of your choice!
- Please let the children be free. Some children may like to mix the colours as well by swirling the paint so it will be a swirl design rather than a print!
- Notice how the colours change as they blend with the crossover of the colours whether you are printing or swirling the colours!

<u>Activity:</u> Gather your recycle tools together. They may be items from indoors or outdoors. When you are done with the tools either wash them and reuse or wash them and recycle into appropriate bins. Remember plastic wrap is also recycled material.
