Project #551: Natural Flower Vase on Cardboard!

- Cut a Rectangle shaped piece of cardboard. This can be done from a box that may be recycled at a later date.
- Add a print of a Vase to this or draw your own vase.
- Children may like to colour the vase.
- Above the vase poke small holes into the cardboard.
- Gather some natural flowers such as dandelions, daisies or other natural flowers, stems and leaves you may like to use.
- Attach these through the small holes you have on your cardboard above the vase.
- Perhaps you have some dandelion seeds that could be glued onto your project.
- Use a glue stick to spread in various areas of your creation.
- Sprinkle the seeds onto the glue area.
- Sparkles could also be used.
- Try some tiny pieces of cotton.
- Try using a QTip dipped in paint to add some details.

Activity: Gather your natural items while taking a nature walk. Bring your items to an area for discussion. Talk about what you found! Place your natural items on a “Science Table”.
