### Project #558: Musical Instrument Ideas!

- Wiggly Ribbons on Pipe Cleaners.
- Scarves from scraps.
- Tin Cups.
- Shakers from plastic bottles or tin cups.
- Bean Bags from scraps of fabric and beads.
- Metal Spoons.
- Metal or plastic sifters.
- Washing boards.
- All of these items can be used in various creative ways.
- Wiggly Ribbons are simply tied to pipe cleaners.
- Scarves can be cut from scraps of material with end finished by hand or machine sewing or just left alone and the fraying of fabric is jus another process and fun!
- Tin Cups could be painted with acrylic paint.
- Shakers can be made from placing beads in a recycle plastic bottle and lid put on plus taped closed securely to keep the beads intact (especially younger children as beads may be a choking hazard)
- Bead in a cloth made bag work very well (I added some soft foam in the bags as well for a different texture and softness. These may be easier to balance on head for example)
- Sifters or old wash boards can be used by scraping them with a wooden spoon.
