Project #563: Father's Day Cards!

- Fold a piece of construction paper in half cross ways.
- Place an insert onto the top such as No 1 Dad!
- On the inside type a verse to add or choose from Father's Day clip art or online verses.
- Children may add details as they like with drawing.
- Try some stickers.
- Try making some small tools, cars, trucks, flowers, or other shapes you wish to add to the card. These may be cut out and glued onto the card with a glue stick.
- Try some stamps.
- Try some QTip painting very lightly onto the card.
- Older children may be able to sign their name with a felt marker.
- Younger children may sign their name as well. This could be a simple shape and that is fine too as they are learning.
- Letter and number stickers could also be used.
- How about stickers that say something nice like "Great Guy"
- Children without a Father may also make a card for the person of their choice.

Activity: Take Your Loved one out for lunch. Make some food together. Go on a picnic. Go to a restaurant. Go to the Beach. Sing some songs.
