Ann's Creative Corner Project #564: Father's Day Footprints!

- Print out a Footprint type page.
- Glue this onto a piece of construction paper.
- Have the children sign it or add some details with Felt markers or crayons.
- After the details are done it is time to Paint the child's foot! Please do this only if the child is comfortable with having their foot/feet painted.
- Have a bucket of soapy water or a cloth on hand to wipe the child's painted foot.
- Best for this activity to be done outdoors.
- When a child has a thin layer of paint on their foot/feet, place the child's feet onto the paper.
- This can be slippery, so hold the young children steady while in the process of printing.
- Place the child's foot into a bucket of warm soapy water to wash!
- Add some sparkles with a shaker!

Activity: Walk and Talk
