Project #566: Summer Sunshine!

- Cut some round circles out of yellow construction paper.
- Use the scraps of paper to create the "Rays" for your sunshine by cutting long narrow strips of paper.
- A round coffee filter may also be used as the basis for your sunshine. Glue this filter onto the yellow circle
- You may also like to add a serrated edge to this with "Pinking shear" type scissors.
- Use a glue stick to glue the sun rays onto the circle.
- Children could add facial features to the sunshine.
- Adding some stickers for eyes is another idea.
- Sparkles or tissue paper also would look nice.
- Try some stamps such as pictures or letters.
- Yellow cellophane would also look nice.
- Add sunglasses to your sunshine creation.
