Project #567: Ladybugs!

(By Kids Care Preschool and Family Place)

- Using red or orange construction paper cut out the Head/Body shape of the ladybug or cut two circles that may be glued together with a glue stick.
- With your leftover paper or other scraps of paper, cut out some small circles for the ladybugs spots. Most spots are black but could be any colour you like.
- Cut out the legs from scrap paper as well.
- Antennas too!
- Draw the wing details for the body if you like with a felt marker, crayons or pencil crayons.
- Cut out wings and attach them to your lady bug.
- Attach the legs with a glue stick. (6 are what insects have but children can use more or less)
- Attach the antennas to the head part of the bug with a glue stick.
- Draw the eyes or use sticker eyes.
- Try using a Qtip for painting the ladybug in lightly brushed paint.
- Small Bingo Dabbers may also be used for the spots.
