### Project #570: Canadas National Animal the Beaver!

- Find some magazine or calendars with the picture of the Beaver.
- Cut these out and glue onto a piece of paper.
- Create a Beaver dam but first draw the shape of a dam which should be a curve.
- Add some stick shapes pieces of brown construction paper.
- Add some texture with some small wood slivers or sawdust would work well for this.
- White non-toxic liquid glue will be easy to spread onto your dam shape and sprinkle the wood chips or sawdust onto this.
- When it is dry you may like to add more details to your creation such as scenery
- The age or stage of the child is dependent on what they choose to do. They may do alot or a little!

**Activity:** Go for a walk and see if you can spot a Beaver Dam. Maybe an area noted for Beavers. Maybe on some areas of rivers. Note the branches they may have chewed off of trees... Look at magazines or books of Beavers and Dams. Look at the Canadian Nickel and you will see the National Animal on it, The Beaver!
