Project #572: Planting Marigolds and Beans!

- If you have Marigold Flowers blooming and going to seed, please collect the pods of the closed flowers when they are shaped like a brown dome.
- Gently spread the pods apart and you will find the marigold seeds in the pod.
- Let these dry out for a day or two.
- Next you may like to plant the seeds in some moist soil and place in the sunlight indoors on a window sill or outdoors if it is warm enough.
- Keep them watered and in the sunlight.
- Let them Grow!
- Beans may also be grown at this time of year as well
- Place the bean seeds into a paper towel and keep moist for a few days.
- The bean seeds will expand and eventually show the start of growing roots.
- Plant these in moist soil and keep them moist plus in sunlight on a window sill, patio or garden. When they grow a little, they may be transferred into a larger pot if on your patio.
