Ann's Creative Corner Project #573: Flower Art!

- Cut out some flower shapes.
- Cut out leaves and stems from green construction paper. These should be various sizes and shapes.
- You may also like to cut our flower petal shapes and circle shapes for the Center of the flowers.
- Children may glue the petals onto the circle to create a flower.
- Add the stems and leaves.
- When the flowers are complete with stems and leaves, think about adding some "Seeds" to the centre of the flowers.
- Create a garden of flowers.
- Use some stamps and stickers if you like. Younger Toddlers like the stamps. However, it is more creative to make your own with paper and seeds!
- Try adding texture with tissue paper or cotton shreds.

Activity: Go for a walk to collect the seeds of flowers. There are many "Blowing Flowers" which are the Dandelions that grow locally. Seeds are abundant and can be used in your artwork!
