- Cut a variety of fish shapes and sizes.
- Use the scraps of the paper to cut into various smaller pieces.
- Have some tissue paper available in various sizes and shapes.
- Felt markers, glitter glue, glue sticks, stamps, crayons, bingo dabbers can also be available.
- Children may decorate a large fish in any way they like adding the eyes if they choose to as well.
- Sticker eyes can be available or googly eyes. However this is more creative if the children DRAW the eyes or eye in any way they like.
- Toddlers and young Preschool children have their own ideas which is fine to be creative.
- Supply some "Bubble Paper" that makes a nice texture on the fish.
- Think of other supplies you have.
