Project #576: Aquarium of Fish!

- Cut out the centre of one thin paper plate.
- Attach this to another paper plate by staples, glue or tape by laying the cut one evenly on top of a full identical paper plate.
- Add some string or ribbon to the top by punching a hole and tie this on for the "Handle"
- Children may add fish to the centre of the "Aquarium" by drawing, stamping and sticker fish shapes.
- Add some "Seaweed" with some tissue paper.
- Draw in other details such as the water with some blue felt markers. This could be done first or last or at anytime in the project.
- Try using some QTips for added details such as Shell Shapes and Rocks.
- Try sprinkling this with sparkles or sand. Liquid sparkle glue also would look nice in dabs or spreading with a very thin paint brush. Glue sticks with sparkles are also nice.

Activity: Go to a pet store to view the fish in the aquarium. Go to an Aquarium such as the Vancouver Aquarium.
