Ann's Creative Corner Project #577: Starfish and Jelly Fish!

- Cut out various StarFish shapes and sizes. Some starfish have more "legs" than others. Poster board or thick construction paper works well for this.
- Use some textures on your Starfish by dropping some non toxic liquid white glue onto the Starfish Shapes.
- Sprinkle your starfish shape/s with sand, small pebbles, and some small sea shells. Barnacles too as starfish often have barnacles on them.
- For the Jellyfish, you may like to use some sandwich wrapping sea through paper to form the shapes of your jelly fish. Scrunch it, spread it and create a "tail" on the end.
- The Jellyfish may be glued onto your "Sea of Water " which could be some cardboard coloured or painted Blue or Green.
- Add some Seaweed by placing cut out seaweed shapes onto your creation.
- Sprinkle this with some sparkles that would enhance the Jellyfish.

Activity: Go to a cold part of the ocean and you may see the Jellyfish. Be sure not to touch them as they can be poisonous to touch. Also leave them in the water as they need water to survive. You may also see Jellyfish in an Aquarium.
