Project #578: Tools, Gadgets and Construction!

- Gather some boxes, boards, frames, cardboard, paper and other items that you may need for your own “construction project”
- When outdoors or indoors, see how you can put your creation together.
- Try using strong tape such as Duct tape or packaging tape.
- Younger children will need help with the cutting and placement of the tape.
- If your child is a little older and capable of use a hammer and some nails, they may try this with some supervision.
- Younger children may like to use some soft foam pieces and some chopsticks or wooden popsicle sticks may work to attached the pieces together.
- Try adding some colour to your creation with some felt markers, bingo dabbers or non toxic paint.
- Add some greenery to your project using natural items you may find in your area or yard.
- Sticks, leaves, flowers etc may be used.
- Cardboard tools could also be an art project!
