Project #586: Colours!

- Fun with Colours so choose any scrap of colourful paper you can find.
- Cut your paper, snip it, scrunch it, tear it, wet it, fold it!
- Take your scraps of various designs and textures and make a collage.
- Try tracing around your collage and find the "Shape" it makes.
- Add to this shape if you like or extend it some more with more paper.
- Try shapes such as triangles, rectangles and squares. Younger children and Toddlers can start learning their shapes and colours by naming them as the process of art goes.
- Try painting with a QTip or some small sponges and see how the colours blend and change.
- Try placing your project in a window and see if the colours change or are the same.
- Try making a Colour Wheel as shown below.

Activity: I Spy Game!

The leader says "I spy with my little eye something that is the colour of Yellow for example. Others will try to find the object that the leader is thinking of. It could also be a shape or a texture that you spy! For younger Toddlers and children, you may like to keep the game very simple and give hints to them.
