Ann's Creative Corner Project #588: Watermelon Art!

- Have some paper plates ready.
- Cut triangle shapes for Watermelon slices.
- Add the red interior to these pieces with red paper or by colouring them red.
- Add some watermelon seeds which could be real watermelon seeds or paper or drawn on specs for seeds.
- Add some texture with some red tissue paper.....
- Try making separate slices of watermelon or glue these onto to a paper plate.
- If you use a paper plate, you may like to colour the edges green as well as you may want to colour the back of the plate green, yellow and brown as watermelon goes through various ripening stages.
- Have fun!

Activity: Watermelon party! Enjoy some watermelon together. Adults and children can help with preparation. Adults can cut the large watermelon for safety out of reach of the children. Then cut the rind off the red watermelon fruit. Children can then cut the soft watermelon pieces and enjoy eating this together.
