Project #593: Colours!

- Lets make a colour wheel.
- Using primary colours, Red, Yellow and Blue create 3 wedges from a circle in even shaped increments.
- These wedge pieces can be placed onto a circular paper plate to create the start of your colour wheel.
- These are the primary colours.
- Next create 3 more slimmer wedge pieces of Green, Orange and Purple.
- Place the green between the yellow and blue. Place the purple between the red and blue and place the orange between the red and yellow.
- So now we have the secondary colours!

Activity:

I spy something that is Yellow. Children can find various yellow items. Carry on with all the colours of the wheel. Play this game as long as the children like. Take turns being the leader.
