Ann's Creative Corner Project #590: Bee Hives!

- Cut out a bee hive shape from some brown or beige construction paper.
- Add some details with felt markers or crayon to form the outside of the beehive. These are usually a "u" or "y" shapes to repeat over the outside of the beehive.
- Cut out some small yellow round or oval shapes to glue onto your bee hive. These shapes can be made into small bees flying around the beehive.
- Glue the beehive shape onto another piece of paper of any colour you like. Earth tones are more natural for this project.
- Add some texture possibly with some sand or soil to make the beehive feel natural.
- Fill in some details on your little yellow "bee" shapes.

Activity: Visit a bee farm if you can. Listen for safety instructions and education on the process that bees create the "Honey" in which we may be eating. Visit the bee farm store at the RiverDistrict area and purchase some fresh natural honey. Have this with you Toast! View and buy natural and pasteurised honey from your local store....
