Project #595: People

- Cut out a person shaped template or a printed paper.
- Add details such as the facial features.
- Add some string or wool for hair.
- Try adding shapes for the clothing of your person. Use various shapes to reflect the clothing you wish to put onto your person. This could be the shape of pants, shorts, capris, dresses, shirts, blouses etc.
- When you are done with your colouring and glueing of the shapes, think about adding some texture to your project. This could be pieces of fabric attached with non toxic Liquid White Glue.
- For older children, a glue gun could be used with supervision as they can get very hot and are difficult to manage as the wax with be stringy and dries quickly.
- Make many smaller people shapes.
- Make a simple head shape.
- Try doing some various expressions for your faces.
