Project #604: Fall Squirrels!

- Cut out the shape of a Squirrel from Brown, Black or Beige Construction paper.
- Provide this shape along with some pieces of wool cut into short lengths.
- Children may glue the wool onto the Squirrel Shape using non toxic glue such as liquid white glue. This will work best with the wool to hold it securely.
- Children may also draw in some details such as the eyes, nose and mouth.
- Some children may like to use sticker eyes and some older Preschool children may use Googly Eyes (Choking hazard for some children so refrain from these if the child puts the items in their mouth)
- Try bingo dabbers on your squirrel could be fun for some children
- Paint with a Qtip so not too much paint on the Squirrel.
- Attach a paper Nut shape to your Squirrels paws.

Activity: Go on a Squirrel Walk!

Go for a walk and notice the many squirrels that are gathering their food for the winter. Notice that they are growing thicker fur coats as well. Notice the various colours of squirrels. See how they climb. See how fast they are!
