Project #605: Fall Acorns!

- Cut out the shape of an acorn nut on brown construction paper.
- Cut out the "hat" (top) out of a different shade of brown.
- Glue "hat" onto the top of your full acorn nut shape.
- Add details such as criss cross lines to the "hat" top.
- Add any details you like to the nut part. These could be lines to create the shape of the nut.
- Young children may colour it as they like. It is their own ideas that make it fun!
- Try adding some leaf shape to this by simply glueing on small leaves created out of left over construction paper.
- Try glueing on small scraps of paper.
- Glue on some real leaves that you may have gather from outdoors.
- Scrunch and dry some leaves as well so these would give your project some texture when glued onto it.
- You may like to staple two shapes together and "Stuff It" with scraps of tissue paper for depth.

Activity: Acorn Hunt!

Go for a walk and you may find some acorns that have fallen from the trees. Go to a Country market and they may sell them there.....
