Ann's Creative Corner Project #607: More Fun with Leaves!

- Cut our large leaf shapes and place on your easel.
- Paint them! Use Felt Markers! Use crayons! Glue and Glitter if you like!
- Make stuffed large leaves. Cut out two identical simple leaf shapes.
- Staple part of this together.
- Fill with your scraps of paper.
- Staples closed and paint them!
- Press fall leaves into waxed paper or sticky clear paper. Place these onto your window or door.
- Crumble Fall Dry leaves and use them for a collage!
- Make a paper leaf mobile by cutting out small leaves and attach with a short string to a natural tree branch (find them outside on the ground not off the tree)
- Make a Fall tree by starting with brown slips of paper to make the trunk and the branches.
- Use small colourful paper leaves to glue onto and off your Fall tree!

<u>Activity:</u> Go on another leaf and branch hunt. Dance and Twirl like a leaf. Make up your own songs with familiar tunes. Use the leaves as a paint brush!
