Project #608: Harvest Apple Ideas!

- Cut some apple shapes.
- Glue tissue paper onto them
- Try painting them and blending the colours.
- Use some diluted food colouring to squeeze onto the apple shape.
- Attach paper leaves by glueing them on.
- Use your scraps of paper to add colours to your apples.
- Make an apple tree with branches, leaves and apples.
- Apples are various colours and shapes.
- Make a collage of apples from magazine or newspaper clippings. Calendars are also great for finding natural apple photos.
- Make a stuffed apple by cutting two shapes the same, staple part, stuff with scraps of paper and then paint! Or colour them first with crayons or felt markers.
- Bingo dabbers are also nice to add colour to your apple project. A large tree on a poster Board could work well with Bingo dabbers for the apples. Let dry and draw in some leaves.

Activity: Gather some apples, peel them, cut them and place in a pot. Slowly simmer the apples with a little, not much water. Add Cinnamon and Sugar if needed (Often applesauce is better without sugar)
