Ann's Creative Corner Project # 610: Thanksgiving Turkey Art!

- Choose a variety of ways to make a Turkey!
- Use a full cut out shape and add feathers by glueing them onto your Turkey shapes. Add the eyes by drawing or use sticker eyes.
 Children often choose to put two eyes on even if it is a side view.
 That's okay too!
- Turkey body shape front view could be another choice. Cut our feathers to glue onto this shape. Add cut shapes for beak and feet.
 Add eyes and details as you like.
- Hand prints also make a good Turkey Feather arrangement. Paint the child's palm of the hand and make prints for your turkey. The body basic shape could be the Center.
- Paint Turkey shapes on the table or large ones on an easel.
- Use textured paper such as tissue paper for details while glueing.
- Try using natural items such as leaves from outdoors. This will make nice Turkey Feathers!

Activity: Visit a petting zoo.

See the various animals and they may have a few Turkeys and chickens to see. Country Farms which sell fruits and vegetables are great for this. Check out your neighbourhood!
