Project #611: Harvest Horn of Plenty!

- Provide a horn of Plenty Shape such as from a print or construction paper.
- Draw in the details such as the curved lines of the horn of plenty.
- For the inside you could colour the various fruits and vegetables if it is a print. Add some texture paper to this for highlights of the fruits and vegetables.
- Make a horn of plenty using magazine or newspaper photos of healthy Fruits and vegetables.
- Find Fruits and Vegetable calendar pictures which as good quality and nice to cut out and glue onto your project.
- For younger children and Toddlers who do not use scissors yet, provide pre cut pictures or printed shapes of the fruits and vegetables to glue on.
- Children who are able to use scissors, can cut the shapes they way they like. It's okay to cut or snip the pictures.
- Younger children or Toddler may also like to "Rip" the fruit and vegetable pictures. That okay too as these colourful pieces can also be glued onto the project.
- Try adding natural items such as the leaves of the fruits and vegetables. Use fresh or dry them first in Newspaper folded flat and pressed.
