- Trace your child's hand or make a handprint by painting the child's hand and pressing it onto paper.
- Children may add small colourful paper leaf shapes to this to create a Fall Tree.
- Have some Qtips available too so they may paint some small leaves.
- Supply a printed tree that the children may add Falling leaves to and around as the leaves are "Falling"
- Use some dried or whole fall leaves for glueing.
- Use some flexible Fall leaves as paint brushes.
- Make a Fall tree by glueing the Tree Trunk and branches from some brown construction paper together.
- Add some tiny construction paper leaves to this.
- This would also make a nice group project with various handprints on a larger tree shape!
