Project #619: Halloween Cats!

- Create a cat shape of the body and head. Black is great for spooky Halloween fun!
- Cut out shapes for the ears, paws and tail.
- Children may then put the pieces together to form their own version of the cat.
- Toddlers and Preschoolers have their own ideas which is fine. You could offer a photo of a cat for guidance.
- Children may fill in details of the face and toes, claws of the cat.
- Add some black string or wool for the body using liquid non toxic white glue.
- Felt pieces may work well for this project as well. Use liquid white glue for felt but a glue stick may also work for felt.
- Try using chalk on the black cat if it is black construction paper!

Activity: Cat Walk, Pet Store visit, Cat Stretch

Go for a walk and see how many cats you may spot.

Go to a pet store.

Do cat actions such as the Cat Stretch. Great exercise to do the cat Stretch with your back while on hands and knees!
