Project #620: Witches Hats!

- Cut out a slim black triangle for the body of the hat. Maybe add a curve to the top of the triangle for the shape of hat.
- Cut a curved Band for the bottom of the hat that can overlap the bottom of your triangle. This would look good in orange or yellow construction paper.
- Glue the curved band onto the bottom of your Hat to form the base of the hat.
- Add details to the Band of the hat such as a buckle shape or maybe some Halloween stickers.
- Add some details to the hat part with chalk, sparkles, felt markers, stamps etc.
- If you would like to Wear the hat, you may like to make a continuous band to measure around the child's head. Staple, glue or tape after measuring the child's head.
- Use felt to make some smaller hats for a felt story.
- Make up your own story.

Felt Story: 5 Little Witches Hats!

5 little witches hats flying in the dark sky,

One flew away and there were 4

4 little witches hats flying by the moon....

Continue the story while you make up where the hats went until there is none left. Children can participate by taking a hat off the felt board or you may pass a hat to each child. If there are many children, repeat the story or have more hats!
