Project #616: Halloween Ghosts!

- Gather some paper towels.
- Scrunch one paper towel and place in the centre of a coffee filter.
- Twist it closed and attach tape or string to the "Neck Part" to create the head of your ghost.
- Next use some felt markers to dab on the eyes and mouth of your ghost.
- Try adding other materials such as liquid sparkles.
- Try cutting out various ghost shapes from white construction paper.
- These can also be designed by the children with felt markers, bingo dabber and paint to create the ghost face.
- Try making some small ghosts from construction paper.
- Use a hole puncher to punch holes and attach some wool or string.
- Attach these smaller ghosts to a pipe cleaner, straw or stick to create a mobile.
