Project #617: Halloween Bats!

- Cut a bat shape with the head wings and feet.
- Children may fill in details of the wings with lines, add some facial features or just randomly paint or colour them
- If you would like to make a mobile, punch a hole in the top and add string or wool to hang your bat/s.
- Glue some "Bats" onto another piece of construction paper to create a Bat Scene.
- Add a haunted house, pumpkins or other Halloween ideas to your scene.
- Use Qtips and white paint for intricate painting.
- Maybe wisps of white paint in the sky would be creative....
- Add some sticker if you like to add some colour and details
- Sparkles for the Sky would be great for you bats.
- Make a tree shape for your bats to hang from.
- An old barn shape would be good for the bats to hang from or the trees.
