- Create evergreen tree shapes of various sizes and shapes!
- Decorate with Felt markers, crayons and stickers!
- Add some tinsel or sparkles.
- Try using QTips to make some thin lines on your tree/s.
- Try folding two trees together and glue one side securely.
- When this is dry, open it up and you will have a 3D tree that can stand up. These trees can be decorated too and then you may want to make a Christmas Tree scene by standing many trees of various sizes onto a table or even glue them onto a firm piece of cardboard
- The Cardboard may be coloured or painted too!
- Another idea is to cut out a circle and then cut it in half to form a half circle. Thin paper plates may also be used,
- Twist your half circle to form a Tree shape. Staple or tape into place. Decorate with QTip painting or sparkles!
