Ann's Creative Corner Project #635: Stocking Art!

- Make sock shapes from construction paper of various colours and sizes.
- Try stapling or taping two socks together to make a sleeve to place some thin item in.
- Secure the top of the "Stocking" by placing some tape all around the edge.
- Use poster board or wallpaper to make a stronger stocking and then punch holes with hole punchers. Weave string, wool or ribbon through these holes and tie a "Handle" on the top with this.
- Children may like to decorate with cotton balls, string or wool.
- Use a hole puncher to punch a hole into one edge of the top of the stocking. (the tape with help it not tear at that point)
- Attach a thin ribbon through the hole punched hole and tie it in place maybe with a bow...
- Continue to draw, use stickers, glue paper sequins etc onto the stocking shape. A glue stick should be fine for this as the stocking will need to dry before hanging.

<u>Activity:</u> Find some Christmas and celebration slim paper items to place into the stocking/s. Hang them up on door knobs or cupboard door knobs. Away from hot sources of course. NOT INTENDED for a fireplace!
