Project #638: Santa Projects!

- Let's make a Santa using a template picture or by using shapes to create Santa Claus.
- If using shapes such as the head and body shapes, glue these together.
- Glue the Santa Suit, boots, hat and gloves on after the body is glued together.
- Add some details such as the buttons using round stickers or a crayon or felt marker.
- Add the beard and hair by adding some wool or cotton.
- Trim the hat in cotton.
- Add some details to the boots if you like such as shiny paper to make the "rubbery look"
- If you use a colouring sheet of a template of Santa, add details with the colouring of the Santa as well as use some wool, string etc. The paper printed Santa may also be glued onto construction paper first.
- If you have your Santa on paper, think of things you may like to draw around the Santa such as a Christmas Tree, Presents etc.
