Project #639: Reindeer, Sleigh and Santa!

- Make two handprints by painting your hand and placing one print above the other print.
- Using the upper part as the reindeer's head, add some facial features. The antlers are the 4 upper finger prints.
- Next take some scraps of brown paper to add form the antlers to glue onto your reindeer shape.
- Add some hoof details to the lower four finger parts of the hand to create the legs and feet of your reindeer.
- Add some details to the body of the reindeer such as lined details or some lightweight wool or setting to improvise the fur.
- If you like, make more reindeer.
- Find a template of a sleigh. Colour this in and attach your reindeer/s to the front of the sleigh to imitate pulling the sleigh.
- Add some squares of construction paper imitation "presents" to glue onto the sleigh.
- Add a Santa.
- Stickers may also be used for Santa and the presents.
- Also a sleigh shape may be cut from construction paper or perhaps some Poster board to make it stronger.
- Add some cotton for snow and sparkles to shine.
- Remember Rudolph may lead the sleigh so get the red nose sticker reader for the lead reindeer!
