Project #640: Candy Cane Art!

- Provide the shape of a candy cane with red or white construction paper.
- Provide the "Stripes" with thin strips of red, white and or green, blue, purple or any colours your children may like.
- Pipe cleaners may also be used glue on easily with Liquid non-toxic white glue
- The children may glue these "Stripes" on all along the cane shape.
- Trim off excess paper that may be over the edge.
- Make a mobile of Candy Canes by making many. Punch a hole on one end and attach or thin packaging ribbon on the end.
- Attach these canes to a stick, hanger or even a pipe cleaner to hang up.
- Candy canes may also be made by bending a wire and covered with Festive Paper wrapped around the cane shaped wires.
- Some wire canes could be hung on door knobs as well.
- Try making some candy canes with waxed paper for a see through effect. These may be placed on windows or mirrors.

Activity: Candy Cane Walk!

On some squares of carpet, place one or more candy canes beside various squares. Play some Festive music. When the music stops the children stop. If they stop beside a candy cane, they keep it. Play this game until all children have gotten one Candy Cane.
