Project #641: Christmas Trees and Gifts!

- Cut some evergreen tree shapes.
- Cut some squares, rectangles, triangles and gift bag shapes out of colourful paper.
- Place your Christmas Tree onto another piece of construction paper.
- Children may decorate the tree with sparkles, stickers, drawings, paint with a QTip, small bingo dabbers etc.
- Place the gifts under the tree and decorate the gifts as well.
- Add any other details you would like to your creation.
- Add some people, Add your home, Add your pets, Add friends, Add relatives etc.

Activity: Felt Story

(create this out of felt fabric to share for story time)

Place a tree or more trees on a felt board. Each child may have a felt gift shape or a felt ornament for this story.

As the leader tells the story, they ask the children for the various colours of their felt piece. After the story when all gifts and ornaments are on the felt board, you may like to practice colour naming and counting.
