Ann's Creative Corner Project #622: Remembrance Day Poppy!

- Cut out simple poppy shapes from red construction paper.
- Thin pie plates glued or stapled together may also make a nice poppy shape
- Cut some smaller black circles for the centre of the poppies.
- Provide the children the poppy shape and the circles to create their own poppy.
- For the younger children and toddlers, you may like to add a few lines to create the "Petal" look. Older children and Preschool children may be able to create the lined details themselves.
 Provide a poppy sample but be flexible as this is the child's view of the project.
- Provide some small green centre circle if you like. These will go on top of the black circle in the Centre of the poppy.
- Sparkles are nice for the project too. Liquid sparkles work well or a glue stick and then sprinkle the sparkles on it.
