Ann's Creative Corner Project #626: Community Collage or Map!

- Use various shapes to create a colleague of your community.
- Shapes may be Squares, Rectangles, Circles, Triangles, Hexagon, Pentagon or any other shape you wish to use.
- Supply a blank piece of paper to each child or make a group project on a poster board.
- Think of what is in your community such as your neighbourhood.
- Children can glue the shapes onto the paper or poster board.
- Fill in some details of what the shapes are for. Adults may help with this.
- Encourage the children to think about other details for the collage such as the greenery, water bodies, roads, foliage, and things in the air such as birds or planes, clouds, sun etc.
- Draw some roads and vehicles.
- Add some depth to your collage with some natural items from outdoors such as dried leaves.
- Add some scrunched tissue paper for colours.
- Add a Circle for the sun or cloud shapes.
- Try some real photos Calendar, or magazine pictures to add.
