Ann's Creative Corner Project #633: Winter Tree Art!

- Cut out the shape of an evergreen tree.
- Provide the tree trunk using scraps of brown paper.
- Children may glue the tree trunk onto the center of the tree for details. (this is the child's view of the tree so be flexible as they may choose to put the tree trunk anywhere on their own creation)
- Add some cotton bits to the tree if you like it to be snowy.
- Add some earthy pine needles from outdoors if you like.
- Draw some scenery around your tree if you glue it onto another piece of construction paper.
- Children may also like to draw onto the tree such as making the branches in more detail.
- Make a tree by tracing your Hand as the tree base!

Activity: Tree walk and collections.

Go for a walk to view the various trees. Notice the evergreen trees and the deciduous trees with the leaves gone. Collect what you can. You may find pine cones, pine needles off the trees, coloured leaves etc. These may be use in your project!
