Project #643: Snowman Art!

- Create some round white circles out of paper or use coffee filters, or round cotton pads.
- Children may glue these onto another piece of paper of any colour they choose.
- Add some cotton to the Snowman shape. It is good to pull the cotton apart to fluff it up and also there is less waste and expense.
- Children may add details to the snowman by adding Facial features, hat, arms, feet, hands or mittens etc.
- Try making some details around the snowman such as trees, grass, animals, people.
- Stickers may be used for the scenery around the snowman as well
- Try using Qtips in white paint.
- Sparkles for your Creation are also nice.
- Try some pieces of colourful wool or string cut short. (no long pieces as this could be a choking hazard for young children and Toddlers).
- Try a premade snowman and decorate your paper!

Song or Story: Frosty the Snowman.
