Project #647: Grizzly Bear Masks!

- Cut out some Grizzly bear head shapes as shown below.
- Glue these onto a firm piece of paper such as construction paper.
- Cut around the shape.
- Attach a sticker circle or some tape to both sides of the Mask to strengthen the area.
- Punch a hole into the strengthened areas with a hole puncher. This can be worn if you attach a string to tie around the child's head. Be sure the string is not too long and fairly weak so this will not be a choking hazard.
- For younger children you may want to use a popsicle stick to the bottom of the mask so they may use the mask by holding the stick. These will be easier for them and not a choking hazard.
- Cut the eye holes out.
- Children can draw and colour on the mask.
- After they are done colouring the mask, use a glue stick to spread onto the mask and attach some dark coloured string to imitate the look of the Grizzly Bear.
- Try using bingo dabbers for some young children or Q Tip painting.

Activity: Have a bear parade by marching to some adventurous music. Go on a Pretend Bear Hunt with music. Have some books available with Bears in them.

Felt Story: The Three Bears (classic story)

With this story you may like to add the Moral of the Story which would be to stay safe.
