### Project #658: Valentines Hearts!

- Cut out a variety of sizes of Heart from pink and red construction paper. (or any colour you like)
- It is very easy to make various hearts by folding the paper in half and cutting starting at the fold to create half the heart shape as when you open it, it will be a full heart. The hearts should be various sizes and can vary in shape too. Some may be wide, narrow, large, small etc.
- Use all scraps to make smaller hearts so paper is not wasted.
- Supply the children with sparkles, stickers, felt markers, crayons, glue sticks, tissue paper, shiny paper etc.
- Children may glue the items on and also draw what they like.
- Sparkle glue is nice or a shaker of sparkles.
- Add details such as to and from (Mom, Dad, sister, brother, friends, grandparents, cousins etc)
