- On a large washable tray, pour some liquid non-toxic paint of various colours. Primary colours will be the best as they are the main focus and will change as you mix it.
- Primary colours are Red, Yellow and Blue.
- Use a sponge, spoon, stick etc. to swirl though the colours while you see the changes.
- Note the various colours as they change as in the end it all blends together and will be brown.
- Make stamps with your paint on some paper.
- Make handprints with your painted hand on some paper.
- Try adding some sparkles.
- You may like to stick coloured paper onto the paint before it is dry as it will stick to the paint.
- When your Creation is done and dry, you may like to draw on it too.

Activity: Try placing the liquid paint into some plastic containers.

Mix: Red and yellow Mix: Yellow and Blue Mix: Red and Blue

The secondary colours will be orange, green and purple.
