Ann's Creative Corner Project #666: Ball, Marble Painting!

- Provide Children with a washable recycle type tray.
- Place a sheet of paper in the tray.
- Add some drops of non-toxic liquid paint.
- Provide children with various types of balls or large marbles (be sure the marbles are very large as this could be a choking hazard for your children and Toddlers)
- Children may choose the balls or marbles they like.
- Place them on the paint in the tray and start to tip the tray diagonally without turning the tray over.
- Try using one colour at a time if you like.
- Try one ball, then two etc.
- Or place two or three colors on the tray. Primary colours are the best for this as they mix into all colours.
- When you are done swirling, you may like to add some sparkle to this by shaking them on before the paint is dry.
- Also try tissue paper as it will stick to the wet paint.

There are many books on colours to read to the children. Also some flashcards with colours would be nice.
