## Ann's Creative Corner Project #675: Hats in Windy Weather!

- Create various hat shapes out of various colours of construction paper.
- Provide children with a variety of art supplies such as pom, poms, cotton, paper shapes, stickers, foam pieces such as letters and numbers, sparkles, wool and string.
- Supply glue sticks or non toxic white liquid glue.
- Children may like to draw on the hat shapes with some crayon or felt markers to start.
- After drawings and putting names on the back of the hat, it will be ready for the next step!
- Glue shapes and other details for your own individual design!
- Try making a 3D hat by stapling two hats together and then opening the center. These hats should be larger so the child may wear them.
- If you are making 3D hats, please secure the edge with some Scotch (plastic) tape to ensure they do not rip.
  (Masking tape can tear)

## Story or Felt Hats on a Board:

When the wind blew, in came a Green Hat.

When the wind blew, in came a Red Hat.

Continue this with various colours of hats and various types of hat shapes such as police hat, fire hat, rain hat, clown hat etc.

Ask children to name the colours and types of hats!
